The unemployment rate in the Madera County was 9.5 percent in February 2017, down from a revised 10.0 percent in January 2017, and below the year-ago estimate of 10.1 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 5.2 percent for California and 4.9 percent for the nation during the same period.
