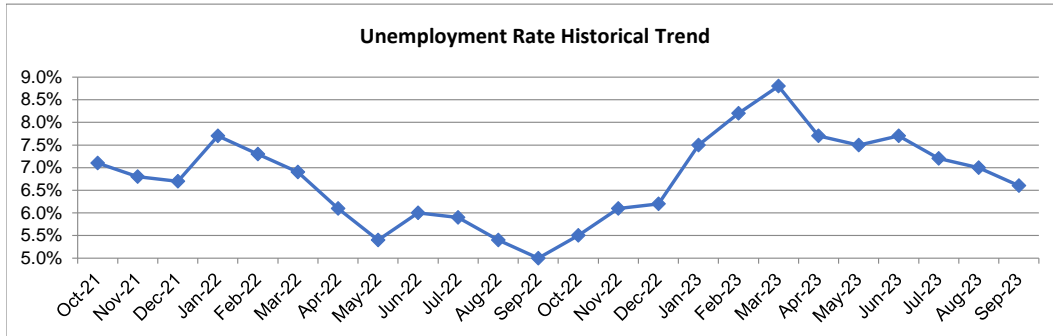


IMMEDIATE RELEASE
 MADERA METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA)
(Madera County)

The unemployment rate in the Madera County was 6.6 percent in September 2023, down from a revised 7.0 percent in August 2023, and above the year-ago estimate of 5.0 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.9 percent for California and 3.6 percent for the nation during the same period.
