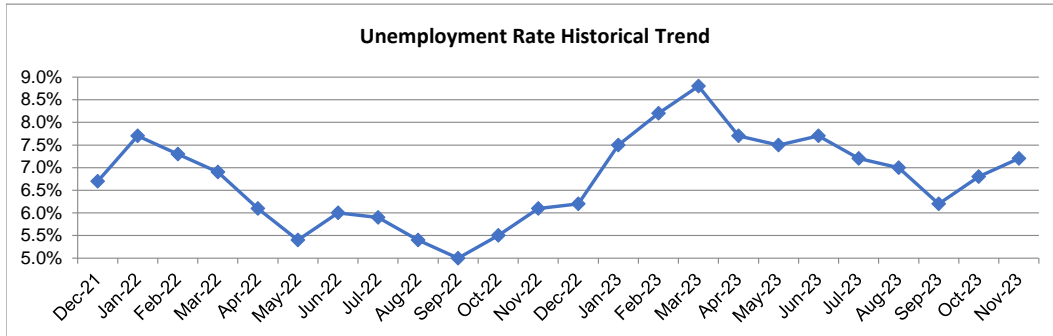


IMMEDIATE RELEASE
 MADERA METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA)
 (Madera County)

The unemployment rate in the Madera County was 7.2 percent in November 2023, up from a revised 6.8 percent in October 2023, and above the year-ago estimate of 6.1 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.9 percent for California and 3.5 percent for the nation during the same period.
