

IMMEDIATE RELEASE FRESNO METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA) (Fresno and Madera Counties)

The unemployment rate in the Fresno MSA was 8.6 percent in July 2025, unchanged from a revised 8.6 percent in June 2025, and above the year-ago estimate of 8.1 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 6.1 percent for California and 4.6 percent for the nation during the same period. The unemployment rate was 8.7 percent in Fresno County, and 8.3 percent in Madera County.
