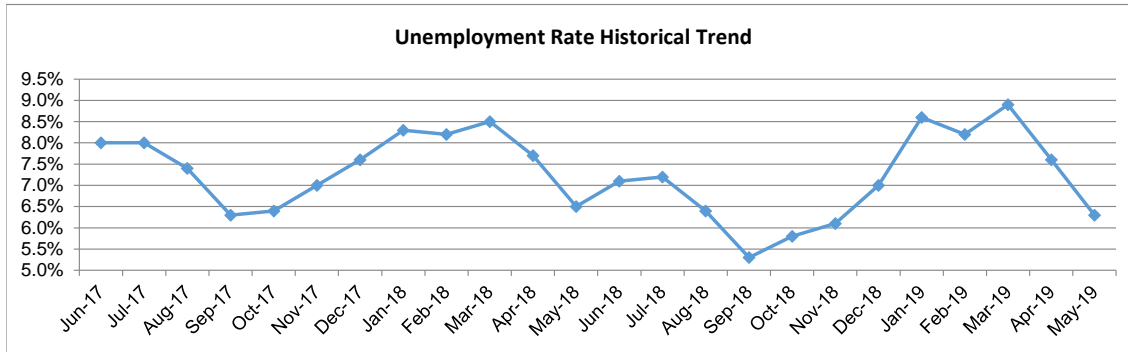


IMMEDIATE RELEASE
 MADERA METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA)
 (Madera County)

The unemployment rate in the Madera County was 6.3 percent in May 2019, down from a revised 7.6 percent in April 2019, and below the year-ago estimate of 6.5 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 3.5 percent for California and 3.4 percent for the nation during the same period.
