

IMMEDIATE RELEASE MADERA METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA) (Madera County)

The unemployment rate in the Madera County was 10.5 percent in March 2020, up from a revised 8.0 percent in February 2020, and above the year-ago estimate of 8.5 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 5.6 percent for California and 4.5 percent for the nation during the same period.
