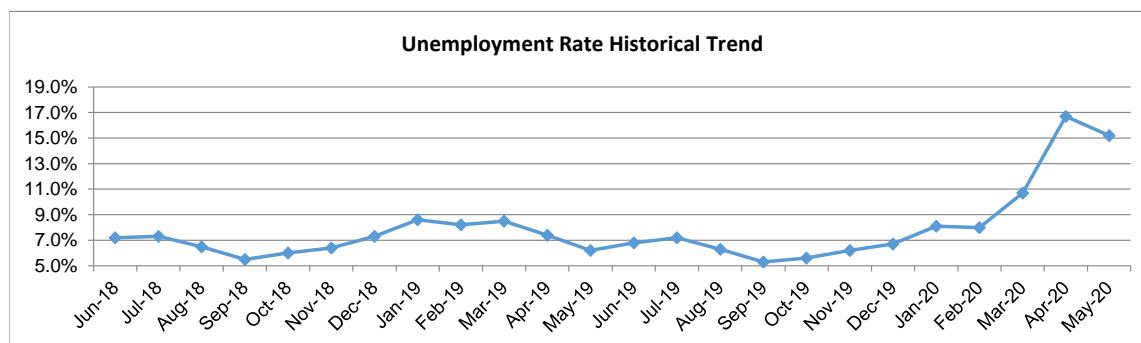

The unemployment rate in the Madera County was 15.2 percent in May 2020, down from a revised 16.7 percent in April 2020, and above the year-ago estimate of 6.2 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 15.9 percent for California and 13.0 percent for the nation during the same period.
