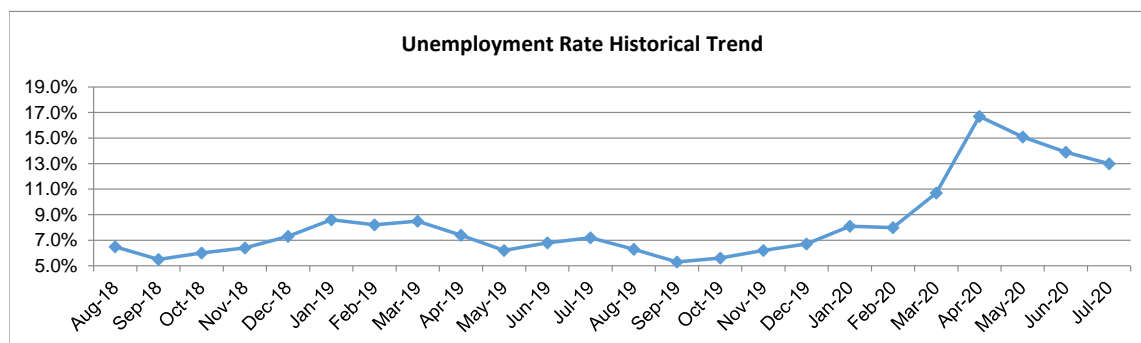


IMMEDIATE RELEASE  
 MADERA METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA)  
 (Madera County)

The unemployment rate in the Madera County was 13.0 percent in July 2020, down from a revised 13.9 percent in June 2020, and above the year-ago estimate of 7.2 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 13.7 percent for California and 10.5 percent for the nation during the same period.
