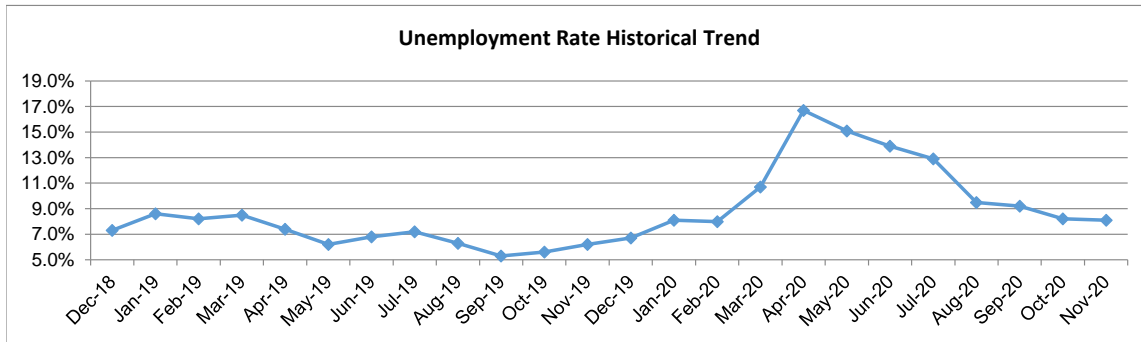


IMMEDIATE RELEASE  
 MADERA METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA)  
 (Madera County)

The unemployment rate in the Madera County was 8.1 percent in November 2020, down from a revised 8.2 percent in October 2020, and above the year-ago estimate of 6.2 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 7.9 percent for California and 6.4 percent for the nation during the same period.
