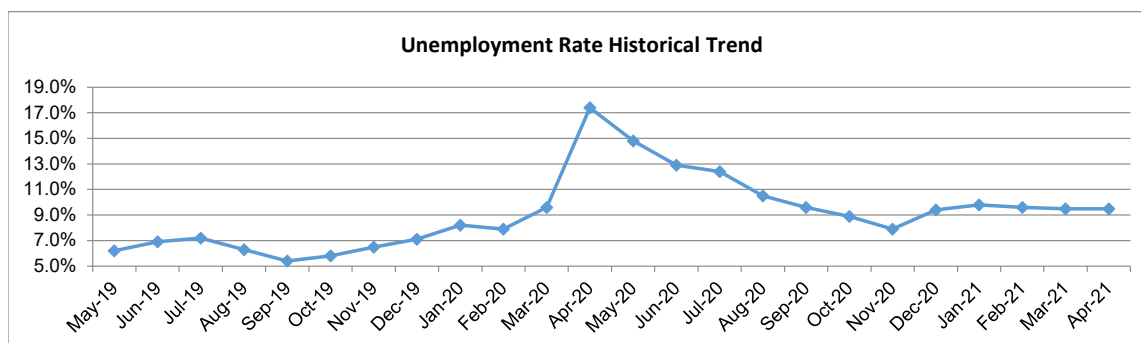


IMMEDIATE RELEASE
 MADERA METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA)
 (Madera County)

The unemployment rate in the Madera County was 9.5 percent in April 2021, unchanged from a revised 9.5 percent in March 2021, and below the year-ago estimate of 17.4 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 8.1 percent for California and 5.7 percent for the nation during the same period.
