


IMMEDIATE RELEASE
 MADERA METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA)
 (Madera County)

The unemployment rate in the Madera County was 8.4 percent in May 2021, down from a revised 9.3 percent in April 2021, and below the year-ago estimate of 14.8 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 7.5 percent for California and 5.5 percent for the nation during the same period.
