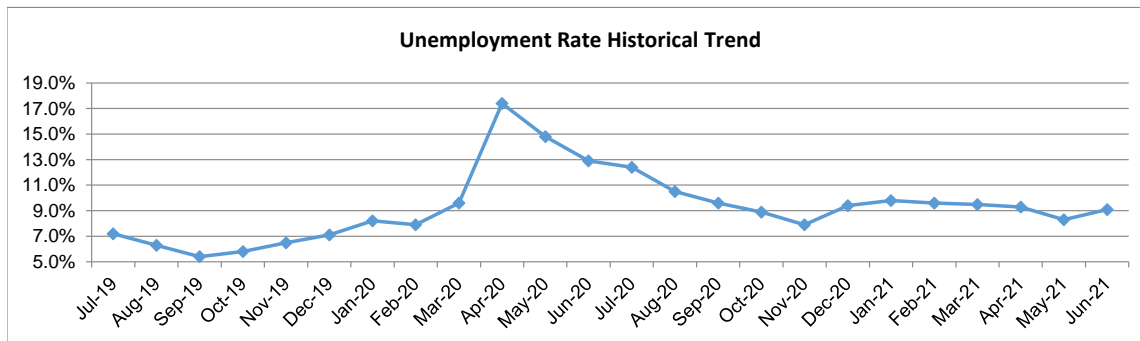


IMMEDIATE RELEASE
 MADERA METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA)
 (Madera County)

The unemployment rate in the Madera County was 9.1 percent in June 2021, up from a revised 8.3 percent in May 2021, and below the year-ago estimate of 12.9 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 8.0 percent for California and 6.1 percent for the nation during the same period.
