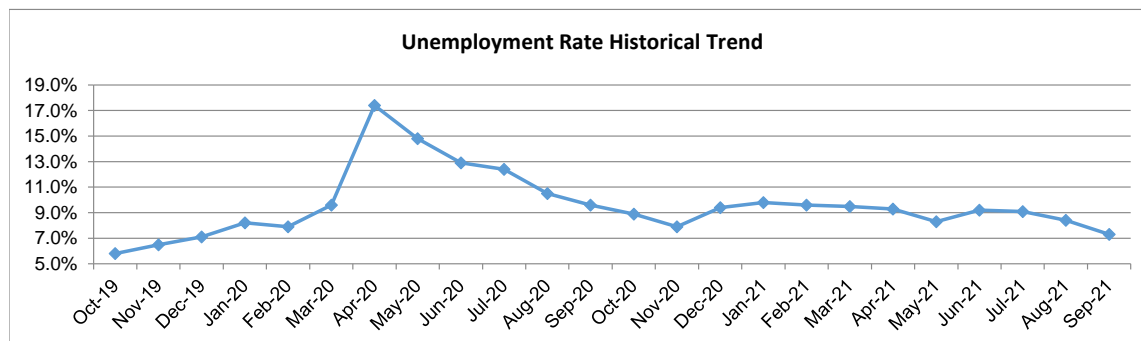


IMMEDIATE RELEASE
 MADERA METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA)
 (Madera County)

The unemployment rate in the Madera County was 7.3 percent in September 2021, down from a revised 8.4 percent in August 2021, and below the year-ago estimate of 9.6 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 6.4 percent for California and 4.6 percent for the nation during the same period.
