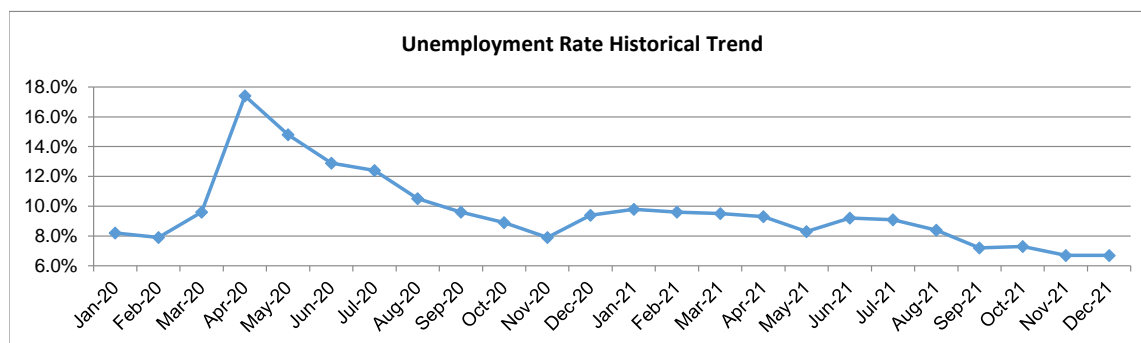


IMMEDIATE RELEASE
 MADERA METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA)
 (Madera County)

The unemployment rate in the Madera County was 6.7 percent in December 2021, unchanged from a revised 6.7 percent in November 2021, and below the year-ago estimate of 9.4 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 5.0 percent for California and 3.7 percent for the nation during the same period.
