

## IMMEDIATE RELEASE MADERA METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA) (Madera County)

The unemployment rate in the Madera County was 7.7 percent in January 2022, up from a revised 6.6 percent in December 2021, and below the year-ago estimate of 10.5 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 5.5 percent for California and 4.4 percent for the nation during the same period.
