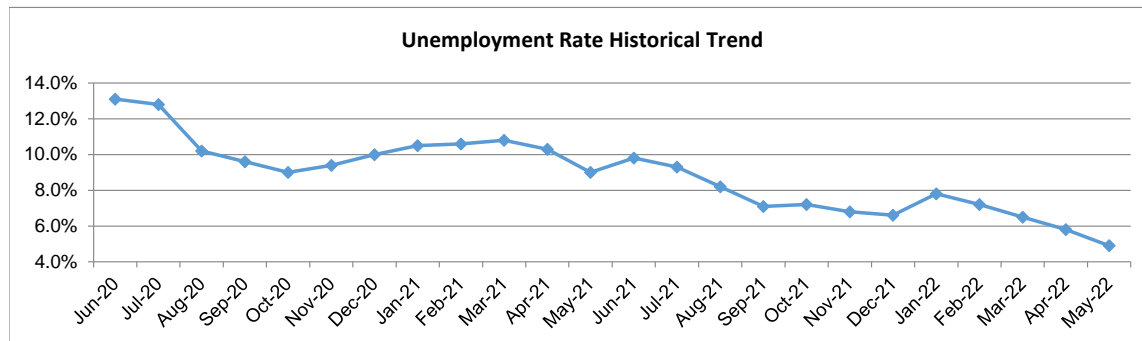


IMMEDIATE RELEASE  
 MADERA METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA)  
 (Madera County)

The unemployment rate in the Madera County was 4.9 percent in May 2022, down from a revised 5.8 percent in April 2022, and below the year-ago estimate of 9.0 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 3.4 percent for California and 3.4 percent for the nation during the same period.
