

IMMEDIATE RELEASE MADERA METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA) (Madera County)

The unemployment rate in the Madera County was 5.6 percent in August 2022, unchanged from a revised 5.6 percent in July 2022, and below the year-ago estimate of 8.2 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.1 percent for California and 3.8 percent for the nation during the same period.
