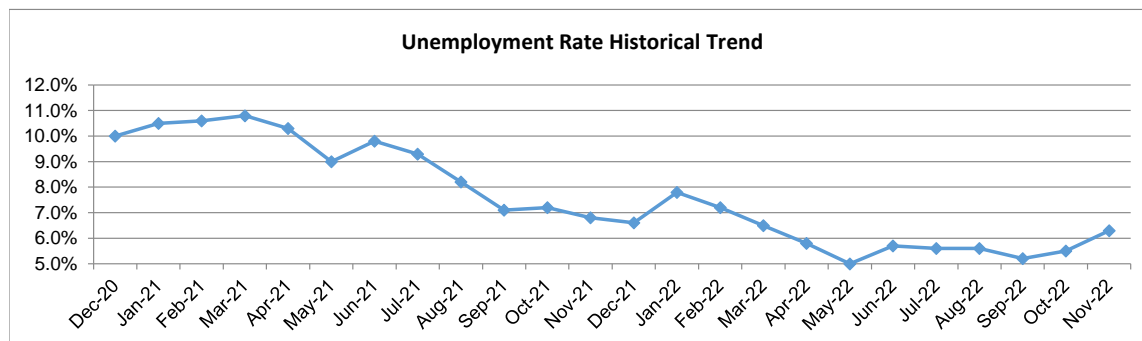


IMMEDIATE RELEASE  
 MADERA METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA)  
 (Madera County)

The unemployment rate in the Madera County was 6.3 percent in November 2022, up from a revised 5.5 percent in October 2022, and below the year-ago estimate of 6.8 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.0 percent for California and 3.4 percent for the nation during the same period.
