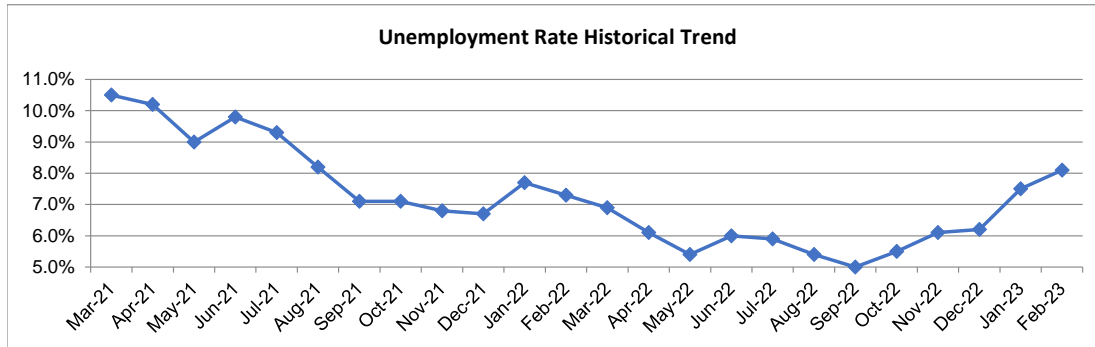


IMMEDIATE RELEASE  
 MADERA METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA)  
 (Madera County)

The unemployment rate in the Madera County was 8.1 percent in February 2023, up from a revised 7.5 percent in January 2023, and above the year-ago estimate of 7.3 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.8 percent for California and 3.9 percent for the nation during the same period.
