

IMMEDIATE RELEASE MADERA METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA) (Madera County)

The unemployment rate in the Madera County was 8.7 percent in March 2023, up from a revised 8.2 percent in February 2023, and above the year-ago estimate of 6.9 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.8 percent for California and 3.6 percent for the nation during the same period.
