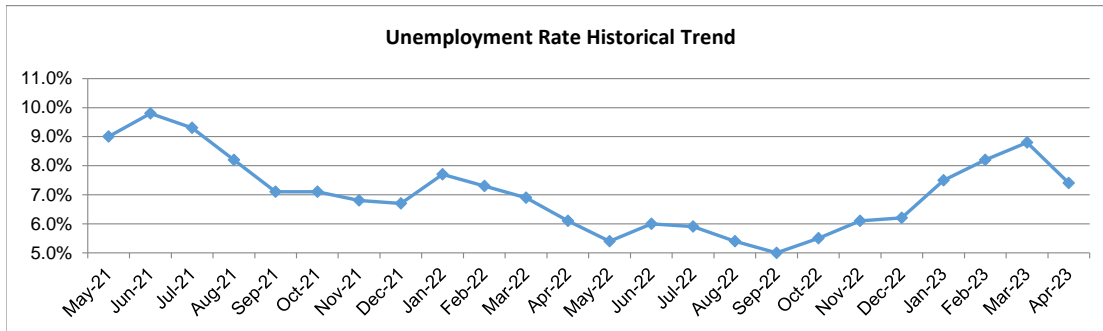


IMMEDIATE RELEASE
 MADERA METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA)
(Madera County)

The unemployment rate in the Madera County was 7.4 percent in April 2023, down from a revised 8.8 percent in March 2023, and above the year-ago estimate of 6.1 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.3 percent for California and 3.1 percent for the nation during the same period.
