

## IMMEDIATE RELEASE MADERA METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA) (Madera County)

The unemployment rate in the Madera County was 7.3 percent in May 2023, down from a revised 7.7 percent in April 2023, and above the year-ago estimate of 5.4 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.5 percent for California and 3.4 percent for the nation during the same period.
