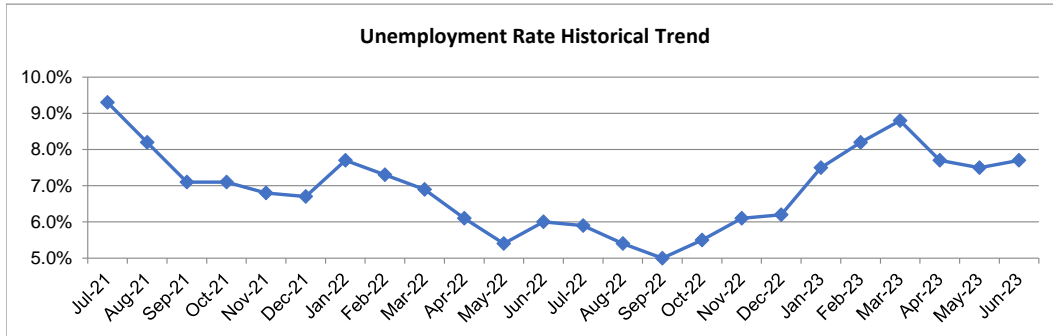


IMMEDIATE RELEASE  
 MADERA METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA)  
 (Madera County)

The unemployment rate in the Madera County was 7.7 percent in June 2023, up from a revised 7.5 percent in May 2023, and above the year-ago estimate of 6.0 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.9 percent for California and 3.8 percent for the nation during the same period.
