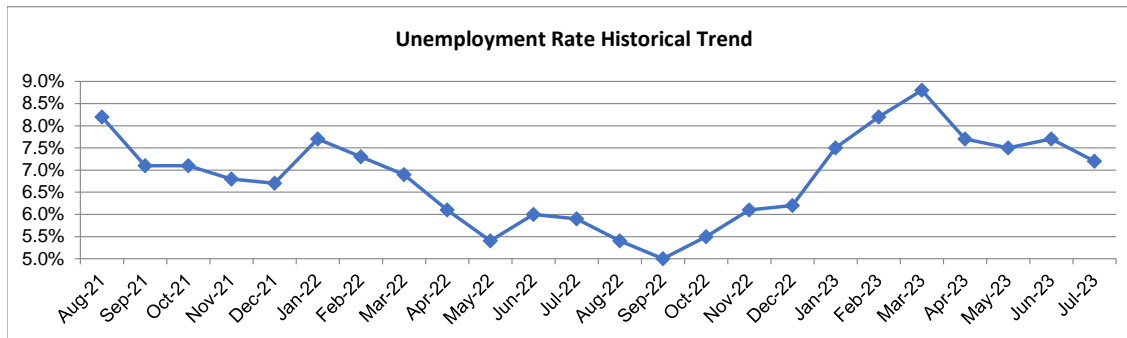


IMMEDIATE RELEASE
 MADERA METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA)
 (Madera County)

The unemployment rate in the Madera County was 7.2 percent in July 2023, down from a revised 7.7 percent in June 2023, and above the year-ago estimate of 5.9 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.8 percent for California and 3.8 percent for the nation during the same period.
